INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Unroll desired size.
- Apply the laser mask to the side of the substrate that is to be laser ablated and blasted.
- 3. Squeegee out the air bubbles and wrinkles.
- Remove the polyester carrier by flicking one edge of the carrier to loosen and then peel.
- Laser through the film to create your sandblastable mask. Please use the suggested laser settings below as a reference point. These settings will vary depending on laser wattage, speed, and artwork.
- Sandblast to desired depth up to 1/16^{th**}. Color fill or finish as desired.
- 7. For removal of the film, simply peel or soak in water.
